



JD Grewell Education Scholarship Application

Applications accepted on a continual basis, scholarships awarded quarterly

The JD Grewell Education Scholarship is funded by the Examination Board of Professional Home Inspectors (EBPHI). EBPHI is a 501(c)(6) not for profit organization whose mission is to develop and maintain high-stakes examinations for the real estate inspection profession and to advocate for high standards for the profession. The National Home Inspector Examination (NHIE) is a nationally recognized examination and is accepted in 29 states as part of licensure requirements for the home inspection profession.

EBPHI established this scholarship in 2018 in honor of JD Grewell, a well-respected home inspector who shared much of his time and talent with EBPHI and the home inspection profession. The scholarship recognizes and supports hard-working and ethical individuals who seek a career in the home inspection profession.

Scholarship Award Application

EBPHI intends to award up to one (1) quarterly scholarship in the amount of \$5,000 for a total of up to four (4) scholarships annually. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide adequate funds for an individual to receive the training needed to become a home inspector; specifically a 60-80 hour training course and associated travel expenses.

All scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the EBPHI Scholarship Committee. Awards will be based on application information and the evaluation of the required essays. The decision of the scholarship committee will be final. The committee reserves the right not to award funds if there are no applicants or if the applicants do not meet the standards of the committee. **The deadline for applications must be submitted by March 1, June 1, September 1 or December 1.** The awards will be announced no later than the 15th day of the following month.

Notification of the award will be emailed to the student. The scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the student upon completion of the training program. The funds will be in the amount of the full scholarship award, with the intention to reimburse for student tuition, books, and /or fees as deemed necessary by the education provider for a minimum 60-80 hour training program in a classroom setting and any travel related expenses. Scholarship recipients may also submit for reimbursement the NHIE examination registration fee upon successfully passing the exam. Information on this additional benefit will be included in the award email.

The denominations to be awarded each year will be decided annually by the EBPHI Scholarship Committee and approved by the EBPHI Board of Directors.

Eligibility Criteria

1. The applicant must be at least 18 years of age.
2. The applicant must be a high school graduate or GED equivalent.
3. The applicant has not had a felony conviction.
4. The applicant must submit the following to the EBPHI office by deadline. Email applications as a .pdf attachment to dkring@executiveoffice.org.
 - Typed completed application
 - Copy of valid US driver's license or Identification Card
 - Copy of high school diploma or GED certificate
 - Three (3) personal references
 - One (1) typed word essay, not to exceed 500 words.

Essay

“Choosing Your Career”: Describe the process you used and the experiences you underwent in your decision to enter the home inspection profession and give your perception of the value of the industry. Also, tell the Scholarship Committee about yourself, why you feel you are deserving of the scholarship and/or why you will make a great home inspector.

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DEADLINES: MARCH 1, JUNE 1, SEPTEMBER 1, and DECEMBER 1

Awards will be announced no later than the 15th day of the following month.
