The Buros Center for Testing hereby confirms that the National Home Inspector Examination (NHIE) program was awarded Buros Stage One Accreditation in 2019 on the basis of a comprehensive review of the program's processes and operations. Additionally, the Buros Center for Testing awarded Stage Two Accreditation of NHIE testing cycles in 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022.
